FINDING THE FUTURE OF FLIGHT JUST GOT EASIER

(Mukilteo, Washington) – The Washington State Department of Transportation recently modified directional signs on I-5 both north and south bound at exit 189 on I-5 making it easier for travelers to find their way to the Future of Flight Aviation Center & Boeing Tour, one of Washington State’s premier visitor attractions. Nearly 200,000 visitors make their way to the Future of Flight each year to enjoy the Boeing Tour, gallery exhibits and attend meetings.

“One of the top challenges for the Future of Flight Aviation Center & Boeing Tour has been getting enough directional signage on I-5 to assist visitors in finding their way,” said Barry Smith, the Future of Flight Foundation’s executive director. “We are very pleased with the leadership at WSDOT that worked with us to make it easier for our 200,000 visitors to find us.”

The Future of Flight Aviation Center is a unique learning and interpretive facility designed to give wings to innovative thinking. The 73,000-square-foot Future of Flight facility includes a 28,000-square-foot Aviation Gallery with interactive exhibits and displays, 9,000-square-foot rooftop observation deck overlooking Paine Field, Boeing Tour Center, conference space for 250 people, special event space for groups of up to 750 people, a 240-seat theater, 125-seat café, Future of Flight Store and Boeing Store.

The Future of Flight Aviation Center & Boeing Tour is open from 8:30am – 5:30pm daily except Thanksgiving, Christmas Day and New Year’s Day. Tours of the Boeing Assembly Plant operate daily at 9, 10, 11am and 1, 2 and 3pm.
