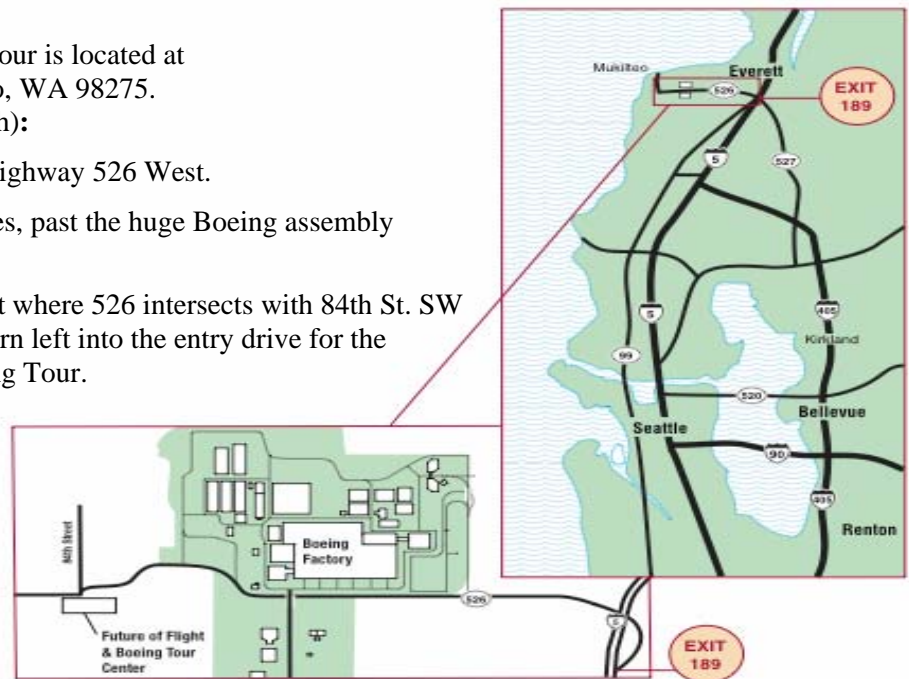
Reservations

Reservations must be made at least 4 weeks in advance by calling the Reservation Call Center: 800-464-1476. Please have a credit card available at the time of making the reservation.

Directions

The Future of Flight & Boeing Tour is located at 8415 Paine Field Blvd., Mukilteo, WA 98275.
From Interstate-5 (North or South):

- 1) Take Exit 189 to State Highway 526 West.
- 2) Drive for about four miles, past the huge Boeing assembly building on your right.
- 3) At the four-way stoplight where 526 intersects with 84th St. SW and Paine Field Blvd., turn left into the entry drive for the Future of Flight & Boeing Tour.



Drop Off and Parking

- 1) Buses: Please do not drop off students in front of the entrance. Buses should follow the signs to the Drop-Off/Pick-Up along the side of the parking lot. After unloading students, the driver should go to the back of the parking lot where the bus may be secured until it is time to depart.
- 2) Cars: There is a large Future of Flight parking lot on site for cars.

If You Are Taking the Boeing Tour:

- 1) All tours are conducted in English and last a little over one hour.
- 2) Please plan on arriving at least 15 minutes prior to your tour reservation time to allow for parking and a restroom stop.
- 3) Children must be at least 4 feet (122 cm) tall to go on the tour. Visitors may not carry babies on the tour, therefore, chaperones with younger children are not appropriate.
- 4) The Boeing Company does not permit still photos or video cameras on the tour.
- 5) There are no personal items allowed on the tour. These items include: purses, backpacks, fanny-packs, cameras, binoculars, cell phones, etc. Lockers are available on-site, for a small fee, at the Future of Flight.
- 6) The tour may require a one-third-mile walk, 21 steep stairs and an elevator ride.
- 7) The Boeing Tour can be done by wheelchair and physically challenged visitors with advance notice. Please advise us of any physical limitations when making reservations.
- 8) There are restroom facilities at the Future of Flight, but restrooms are not available during the tour. Please allow enough time to use restrooms in the lobby before your reservation tour time.

Frequently Asked Questions

1) What if we are late, can we get on the next tour?

Unfortunately, we cannot accommodate late groups for the Boeing Tour. If your group is late and missed the reserved tour time you are welcome to visit the Future of Flight gallery. No refunds are given for late arrivals.

2) Can we pay with a purchase order?

No, our reservation center only accepts credit cards.

3) How many chaperones are required?

We require one chaperone per 10 children. Chaperones must pay admission. Chaperones with younger siblings (i.e. babies in backpacks, etc.) are not appropriate.

4) Can we eat lunch any where in the facility?

There is a small café in the lobby, but it is not available for groups bringing their own lunches. There is nowhere in the facility to eat a brown bag lunch, but in warm weather groups are welcome to picnic on the lawn.

5) Are there any pre-visit materials for teachers?

We are in the process of developing self-guided material for teachers. We hope to have them available by the 2006-2007 school year.
